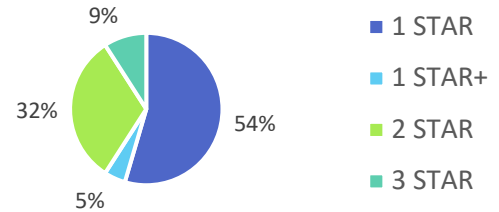

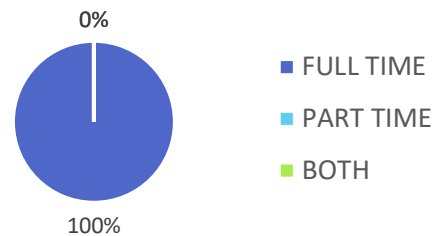

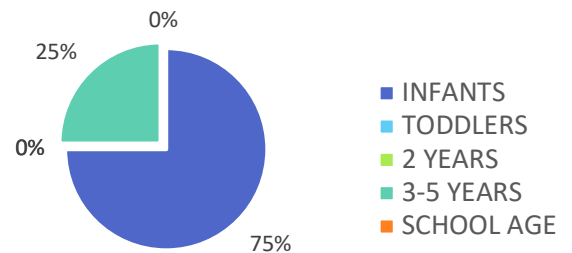
STAR RATINGS FOR CHILD CARE FACILITIES
