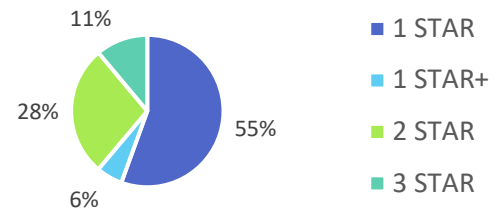

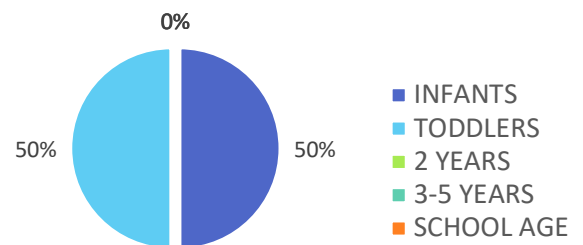


AMOUNT OF CARE SOUGHT
